

SO, YOU'RE A FIELD TRIP CHAPERONE... NOW WHAT?

Here are some tips for being a great one!

Get involved! As you explore exhibits or participate in a program, encourage the students in your group to think about what they're seeing and doing. Resist the temptation to supply students with answers!

Ask questions! While experimenting with exhibits, try asking your group some open ended questions:

- What do you wonder?
- What do you think about that?
- How do you know?
- Have you seen something like this before?
- What did you discover?

Rules. We've got 'em.

- Regardless of their age, stay with your students throughout your visit.
- Our "Farm to Fork" exhibit area (look for the barn) is intended for kids under 5. Older students are welcome to explore here, just give the littles some space.
- It's your responsibility to maintain the good behavior and safety of the students in your group.
- Water table must have adult supervision at all times.
- Please make sure students are cleaning up after playing with exhibits.
